



## Clean Water Project and Farmington Area (7.1) Goals

- To significantly alleviate sewage backups into basements and to reduce street flooding
- To eliminate, to the extent possible, private inflow sources
- To eliminate CSO discharges to the Tremont Street Interceptor
- Reduce CSOs to the one-year level of control

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## Farmington Avenue Area Key Statistics and Goals

- 350 acres + in Hartford and West Hartford
- 9 Primary Contracts
- 31,500 linear feet of new Sanitary Sewer
- 25,500 linear feet of new Storm Drain
- 1,400 homes and commercial buildings
- 13,500 linear feet of existing combined sewer converted to sanitary sewer
- 21,700 linear feet of existing combined sewer converted to storm drain
- 10,250 linear feet of new water mains; various sizes
- Four Current overflow structures to be closed
- Re-activate Tremont Street Interceptor storm drain connection

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## Contract 7.1 – Arnoldale & Beverly Rds, West Hartford

- Project Cost: \$1.59 Million
  - 2,030 linear feet of New Sanitary Sewer to be installed
  - No New Storm Drains
  - Approximately 54 Dwellings & Businesses
  - No Overflow Structure
